Ladies and Gentlemen:

The Department of Environmental Resources has reviewed your Act 537 Plan, dated August 6, 1992 and revised September 15, 1992, and has found it to be consistent with the Department's Rules and Regulations (Chapter 71, Section 71.21). Therefore, your Plan is approved with the following conditions:

- 1. The designated Areas A & B on the September 15, 1992 revision map are not available for development relying on on-lot sewage disposal. Any interim method of treatment proposed for these areas shall include adequate financial security to insure completion of the sewer project within three (3) years.
- 2. Mini-modules may not be used north of the line, designating <u>lime-stone geology</u>, on Exhibit 15-A nor in the shaded areas shown on Exhibit II-19 as within ¼ mile of nitrate samples above 5 mg/liter of N-NO₃. Preliminary hydrogeologic studies are required in these areas (p.III.25A).

It is now South Middleton Township's responsibility to implement the 537 Plan in accordance with the schedules contained within the Plan.

Since your Plan has been approved by the Department, you are now eligible for a 50% Planning Grant as provided under Section 6 of the Sewage Facilities Act (Act 537).
