

# RESIDENTS AND PROPERTY OWNERS OF BOILING SPRINGS VILLAGE

Residents and property owners of Boiling Springs Village are encouraged to attend an important meeting at the South Middleton Township Municipal Building on Wednesday, April 16 starting at 7 PM. The meeting is intended to present the proposed Boiling Springs Livable Community Plan which may become part of the Township's Comprehensive Plan adopted last year and will guide future development in the village.

The Livable Community Plan is being put together by RETTEW, an engineering, planning and consulting organization with offices in Camp Hill. RETTEW has identified four areas of focus that will form the framework of its plan; heritage conservation, housing and community development, land use and transportation.

The two-hour public session will consist of a brief presentation by RETTEW staff using visual graphics including photo images, maps, etc., and will provide a summary of the Plan, as well as opportunities for public comment.
