ORDINANCE NO. 93-12

AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE THE
PLACEMENT OF NUMBERS UPON REAL PROPERTY

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of South Middleton Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1.

All residential houses, places of business, and other such buildings shall be conspicuously numbered for identification purposes. Conspicuous numbering shall include but not be limited to illuminated and reflective numbers placed in such a location as to be visible from the street.

SECTION 2.

Any person who shall violate any section of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof by a summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment shall be imprisoned for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day's violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

If any section, clause, sentence, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, clauses, sentences, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, clause, sentence, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.

SECTION 5. REPEALER.

All other ordinances or parts thereof which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
