

SOUTH MIDDLETON TOWNSHIP
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

ORDINANCE NO. 7-2-65

An Ordinance creating and appointing a Township Planning Commission; providing for appointment of a Commission and setting forth the general powers and duties of the Planning Commission and providing for filing of annual reports.

It is hereby enacted that the Township of South Middleton hereby create a Township Planning Commission to be known as the SOUTH MIDDLETON PLANNING COMMISSION for the purpose of exercising any and all powers conferred and performing any and all duties imposed in accordance with the provisions of the Act of Second Class Townships its supplements and amendments.

The Township Planning Commission hereby created shall consist of five (5) persons to be appointed by the Township Supervisors all of which are residents of the Township of South Middleton and have been appointed with due consideration to geographical and population factors.

All members appointed to serve on the Township Planning Commission shall serve without compensation and shall make an annual report, to the Township Supervisors, showing their transactions and recommendations.

The above Ordinance was unanimously adopted at a regular meeting of the Township Supervisors held on July 2, 1965 at which meeting all the Supervisors were present.
