ORDINANCE NO. 74-02

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A RECREATION BOARD; ESTABLISHING THE NUMBER AND TERM OF MEMBERS; AND DESIGNATING DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE BOARD.

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of South Middleton Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section I: There is hereby created, pursuant to the Act of May 1, 1933, P.L. 103, Article XIX, Section 1901, et seq, as amended, a Recreation Board to be known as the South Middleton Township Recreation Board.

Section II: The Board shall consist of five (5) members, three (3) to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors and two (2) to be appointed by the School District of South Middleton Township. The Board members shall serve for terms of five (5) years, or until their successors are appointed, except that members first appointed shall be so appointed that the term of one (1) member shall expire annually thereafter. Vacancies occurring otherwise than by expiration of terms shall be for the unexpired term and shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments. In making appointments to the Board, due consideration shall be given to representation to various geographic sections within the Township, so that all members shall not be from the same general area. The first members who are hereby appointed for terms which expire December 31 of the year set forth:

Section III: The Recreation Board shall appoint from its membership a Chairman and such other officers as it may be necessary for the orderly procedure of its business, and may adopt by-laws, rules and regulations covering its procedure not inconsistent with the provisions of the Township Code. The Board shall hold regular meetings at such times and places as it shall designate.

Section IV: The Recreation Board shall maintain, operate and supervise the public parks, playfields, and all outdoor and indoor recreation areas and facilities owned or controlled by the Township of South Middleton. Standards, qualifications, and salary schedules for all classifications of recreation employees shall be approved by the Supervisors of South Middleton Township.

Section V: The funds appropriated by the Supervisors of South Middleton Township and budgeted to the Recreation Board shall be disbursed by the fiscal disbursing officer of the Township of South Middleton upon vouchers issued by the Recreation Board and within the budget appropriation made. Funds received by the

Recreation Board from sources other than budget appropriation shall be deposited by the Township of South Middleton to the credit and for the use of said Board, and disbursed as the above budget funds are disbursed, except that funds received by gift, bequest, or otherwise, shall be disbursed in accordance with the terms of such gift or bequest, or the terms of the acceptance thereof. The Recreation Board shall submit annually by the first day of November the requested budget for the following year. Expenditure of funds for purposes and activities of the Board shall be by presentment of vouchers to the Board of Supervisors and disbursement by the Board of Supervisors upon approval.

Section VI: The Recreation Board shall make full and complete reports to the Supervisors of South Middleton Township at such times as may be designated or requested by the Supervisors. The fiscal year for said Recreation Board shall conform to that of the South Middleton Township.

Section VII: Such powers as are now or hereafter be provided by statute of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or by ordinances of South Middleton Township relating to the development and operation of the recreation systems, public parks and playgrounds are hereby vested in the Recreation Board, to be exercised by it, subject to any and all restrictions contained in such powers and ordinances.

Section VIII: The provisions of this ordinance shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of any other remaining provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as legislative intent that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision not been included therein.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 to ORDINANCE NO. 1

An Ordinance amending Section II of Ordinance No. 1 of South Middleton Township by increasing the number of members of the South Middleton Township Recreation Board from five to seven.

It is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of South Middleton Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section I: Section II of Ordinance No. 1 of the Township of South Middleton is hereby amended to provide as follows:

The Board shall consist of seven members, five to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors, and two to be appointed by the School District of South Middleton Township. The Board Members shall serve for terms of five years, or until their successors are appointed, except that members first appointed shall be so appointed for such terms that the term of not more than two members shall expire annually thereafter. Vacancies occurring otherwise than by expiration of terms shall be for the unexpired term and shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments. In making appointments to the Board, due consideration shall be given to representation to various geographic sections within the Township, so that all members shall not be from the same general area. The two additional members who are hereby appointed for terms which expire December 31 of the year set forth are as follows:

Donald E. Slaybaugh 1978
Frances Lebo 1979.

The terms of the existing five members shall remain as previously appointed.

Section II: In all other respects, Ordinance No. 1 of the Township of South Middleton shall remain as heretofore enacted.
