## Compost Site Rules and Conditions

1. Must be a resident of South Middleton Township.
2. Each permit must be affixed with its own adhesive to vehicle and match the vehicle's tag #.  
Attach inside the passenger's side of the windshield. If not attached, you will not be allowed to unload.
3. The compost site is a **no smoking** facility.
4. Please remove all accepted compost items from containers and bags.
5. Leaf mulch and tanbark free to Township residents, but must be hand loaded.
6. Due to the high probability of vehicle damage or bodily harm, Township residents and employees are prohibited from machine loading any product.

The Township staff appreciates the cooperation of all involved with the operation of the compost site, as we pride ourselves in providing a quality product free of charge in a safe environment to all residents.

### Accepted

- Leaves on leaf pile only
- Brush/shrubbery clippings
- Dry ornamental grass
- Logs under 8 inch diameter/less than 6 feet long
- Pine cones & seed pods in compost only
- Shrubbery roots that are free of dirt and stones

### Not Accepted

- Weeds from garden
- Dirt
- Grass clippings, garbage, dirt, stones
- Nuts
- Fruit/vegetables
- Corn fodder
- Corn cobs
- Mulch/old compost
- Construction materials
